#### 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:

Real Club Mediterráneo de Málaga ("RCMM") in cooperation with European Snipe Class Racing Association and Snipe Class International Racing Association ("SCIRA").

#### 2. HOST CLUB AND FLEET:

Real Club Mediterráneo de Málaga and Real Club Mediterráneo Fleet 146

#### 3. RULES:

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS") 2009-2012, the SCIRA Rules of Conduct for Conducting National and International Championship Regattas, and the Deed of Gift for the *Master European Championship*.
- 3.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 3.3 Appendix P will apply.
- 3.4 The decision of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 3.5 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 3.6 RRS 62.2 and 66 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and the requesting that a hearing be re-opened on the last day of recing.
- 3.7 RRS 30.3 will not be used.
- 3.8 RRS 30.2 and 33 will be changed to limit course changes
- 3.9 RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to restrict protest from boats for specific items on the NoR and SI.
- 3.10 Racing Rule 63.7 will be changed to provide that in the event of a conflict between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail.
- 3.11 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

## 4. ADVERTISING:

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

# 5. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY:

- 5.1 This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and Class Member skippers and crews who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year. Skipper to be at least 45 years of age in the year of the regatta. Combined age of skipper and crew must be at least 80 years in the year of the regatta. No skipper or crew shall be eligible to enter any Class championship race unless they possess and present a current Class Membership Card, or its SCIRA-issued equivalent or shows as current member in the SCIRA Official Online Database..
- 5.2 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the entry form and submiting it together with the Bank Transfer Document to <a href="mailto:aacosta@realclubmediterraneo.com">aacosta@realclubmediterraneo.com</a> or <a href="mailto:vela@realclubmediterraneo.com">vela@realclubmediterraneo.com</a> up to 1800 of September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
- 5.3 The entry fees are described in "Additional Information" paragraph.

5.4 All entrants are required to complete the on site registration/check-in process by 1200, friday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

Friday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011: 2 Races Scheduled, Warning Signal First Race at 1300 Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011: 2 Races Scheduled, Warning Signal First Race at 1200 Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011: 2 Races Scheduled, Warning Signal First Race at 1100

### 7. **MEASUREMENT**:

- (1) all boats shall produce a valid measurement certificate;
- (2) all boats are otherwise subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the Class or Race Committee.
- (3) all boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

# 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at on-site registration/check-in on September 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

### 9. VENUE:

The racing venue will be the area known as Málaga Bay in the Mediterranean Sea off Málaga.

# 10. COURSES:

The courses to be sailed are the Class approved courses for Championship regattas as published in the 2009-2012 SCIRA Official Rule Book and SCIRA website.

## 11. SCORING:

- 11.1 The Low Point scoring system of the RRS.
- 11.2 Six (6) races are scheduled and two (2) races constitutes a regatta.
- 11.3 (a) When four (4) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.
  - (b) When five (5) or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

### 12. INSURANCE:

Each non spanish participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €300.500, 00 Euros or the equivalent.

# 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

# 14. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### 15. PRIZES:

3 division of medals will be presented for top three places in the following divisions :

Apprentice master division (45 –54 Years)

Master division (55 -64 Years)

Grand master division (65 Years and over)

Overall Master European Champion will be top placing team.

#### 16. SOCIAL:

There will be an Opening Ceremony and a Prize giving Ceremony scheduled for the evening of Sunday, october 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011, subsequent to the races. Other festivities will be announced at a later date.

## 17. SCIRA REPRESENTATIVE:

The SCIRA Representative will be SCIRA European Representative or his designee.
